The Mid Atlantic Areas Premiere Team Trail – Where The Anglers Come 1st

Tournament Handout

Hudson River – Dutchman's Landing - Catskill, NY – July 12, 2009

Pre-tournament Check-In: Will open at 3:30 AM, closing at 4:30 AM. There will be a 10 minute grace period until 4:40 AM, those teams checking in then will be assessed a 1 pound penalty. After 4:40 AM any teams that are not checked in will be considered a **No Show**.

Official Tournament Start Time: 5:00 AM or Safe Light.

Check-In Time: 2:00 PM (see Rule #15 for those penalties which will be assessed if you are late). When checking in give your launch number to the individual with the orange vest on the end of the launch ramp dock.

Weigh-In: Will commence approximately 20 minutes after Check-In. Only those bags handed out by the Weigh Master will be permitted for transport of your catch to the weigh-in area. Sign your slip, release your catch and return your bag to the weigh station. **Both team members must be present at the weigh-in.**

Legal Limit: An eight fish limit (see Rule #13 for guidelines) of fish measuring 15" per the regulations governing the tournament waters.

Off Limits: Off Limits, will include any areas posted Off Limits by either Local, State or Federal Agencies. You must obey all Local, State and Federal fish and game regulations. **You must have the proper fishing license for the waters you are fishing; if you receive a citation and we are made aware of it, your team will be disqualified.**

Safety: A PFD must to be worn anytime the big engine is running, **this includes during both the launching and loading out of boats.** Your PFD is to remain fastened and secured until the big engine is shut down. **Everyone's boat must stay at idle speed in any No Wake Zone. Absolutely No Passing in a No wake Zone**

Launch Procedure: Line up in start position and proceed past the left dock when your number is called in launch order. **Pull your kill switch when requested.** There will be an approximate 10 second delay from the boat in front of you.
