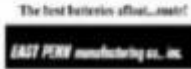

WHY THE ABA TEAM CIRCUIT?

- ☛ **Economy:** Want to pay \$1.75 a gallon for gas again? Split the expenses for each tournament with your partner! You'll **BOTH pay HALF.**
- ☛ **Results:** Two heads are better than one. Partner up with someone that fishes differently than you. You both will learn - you both will do better.
- ☛ **Experience:** Think about the most productive, fun day you've ever had in a bass tournament. We bet if you had your choice, you would fish with that person all the time. Well, 6 tournaments next year can be just like that.
- ☛ **Less Hassle & Frustration:** You know the drill. In a draw tournament, you have **no idea** who you're going to be fishing with. They could step all over your stuff, break your rods, whine all day, never take the front when you need them to, and they hardly ever help to form a winning strategy. **It doesn't have to be that way!**

WHY THE ABA TEAM CIRCUIT?

- ☛ 1 Tournament Per Month: **You don't have to quit your local club to fish the ABA.** Many of our members fish both their local clubs, as well as the ABA circuit.
- ☛ **Fish GREAT waters at "prime time":** The ABA is the longest standing team tournament trail in the northeast. At some venues, we get priority over other trails when booking our tournament dates.
- ☛ **Good Sportsmanship:** You won't find members "muscling in" right where you are fishing. There is a common respect among all ABA members.
- ☛ **Good Competition:** If you're looking for top flight competition to measure yourself against – you have found it here. Get to know some of our teams and you will find them to be open and welcoming. Heck, some of them are downright hilarious!

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Tournaments: Our 2010 tournament schedule is on the side panel for you to review. Great places to fish, at the right times huh?

Classic Qualification: The ABA "Classic" is a two day event that requires qualification. The ABA "Classic" has **no entry fee, and, the biggest payout of the year.** In short, you want to qualify for the "Classic".

Good News!: There are **FOUR** ways a 2010 new team can qualify for the "Classic". Here they are:

1. Top ten point standings in the first three points tournaments (first half)
2. Top ten point standings in the 2nd set of 3 points tournaments (2nd half)
3. Rookie Team of the Year
4. Be the highest placing team at the "Wild Card" tournament that hasn't qualified for the "Classic" already.

Note: Your team must fish 5 of the 6 points tournaments to be eligible for the 2010 Highway Marine Classic.

You could be competing in the ABA "Classic" in your first year!
